

Maternal and Infant Health Initiative Funding Available NYS Department of Health (BMCH)

Components Being Funded

- **A: Maternal and Infant Community Health Collaboratives (MICHC)**, \$13.79 million for 20 to 25 projects
- **B: Maternal, Infant and Early Childhood Home Visiting (MIECHV)**, \$1.18 million for 2 to 6 projects

The New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) will provide grant funding for community-based programs to improve maternal and infant health and to reduce racial, ethnic and economic disparities in outcomes for high-need women and families. The program will work to improve preterm birth, low birth weight, and infant-mortality and maternal-mortality rates using evidence-based and/or best-practice strategies during the reproductive life cycle. The Request for Applications (RFA) consists of two components, as shown in the text box at left, each requiring a separate application.
