

Department for the Aging (DFTA) Case Management Program (CMP) RFP

\$71.7 million dollars will be granted to eligible high-quality providers to implement the Case Management Program to help clients access services, benefits and entitlements. These include Medicaid, Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Personal Emergency Response System, the Senior Citizen Rent Increase Exemption (SCRIE), telephone reassurance, friendly visiting, home-delivered meals and home care to help older adults who live with functional and/or cognitive impairment(s) to remain safe at home and meaningfully engaged in their communities.

Requirements and Duration. Three-year contracts will be awarded to applicants whose proposals are highest rated, technically viable and most advantageous to the City, based on responses to the RFP. There will be 21 awards in designated Community District catchment areas spread among all five boroughs. Applicants may apply in more than one of the 21 competitions by submitting a separate and complete proposal for each one.
