To establish national child traumatic stress centers to provide expertise for specific traumatic events. 5 years.

Recent Funding Success: Our grant writers prepared six responses to a New York State RFA (Request for Applications) to provide up to \$150,000 each to qualifying organizations. Of the dozens of responses submitted statewide, only 30 were approved. But all six applications submitted by our grant writers—a perfect 100%—were funded. We also raised more than \$68 million in *EarlyLearn NYC* funding for child care and educational organizations. We won a Health Workforce Retraining Initiative grant of \$500,000 for a major university. We also prepared responses to state RFPs that secured more than \$6 million for our client to support distance-learning programs for health-career workers and to implement nursing-quality-improvement demonstration projects in nursing homes.
